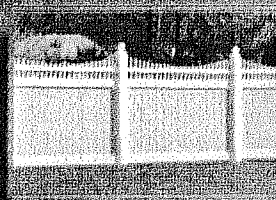
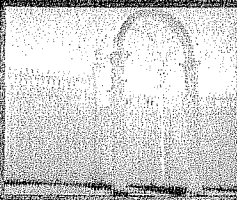

## CHARITY BIKE RIDE FROM JACKSONVILLE, FL TO CENTEREACH, NY

Please help! We need to raise awareness for this Long Island children's charity.

On July 28th, 2007 Jay D'Agostino and William Iaia will return from a 1000 mile 8 day charity bicycle ride from Jacksonville Florida to Centereach, New York by way of Suffolk County Police escort. Upon arrival to McCarthy's Pub, located at 2582 Middle Country Road, Centereach, 631-467-9105, there will be a welcome home party to celebrate the outstanding achievement of these two men. The party hosted by McCarthy's will provide music, food and spirits to all who attend.

The ride is to benefit a local Long Island charity called Angela's House. Angela's House is a group home for young children with special healthcare needs. These children are medically fragile, technology dependent, chronically ill or living with life threatening illnesses. Bob Policastro, the founder of the organization has dedicated his life to raising awareness to this cause after losing his daughter after an accident at birth. Bob has helped families on Long Island who simply cannot care for their children in their homes due to the special healthcare requirements they are faced with. Bob has helped open two facilities on Long Island that help care for children with special needs and plans to open a third this year.

Jay met Bob during the construction of Angela's House II. Jay is a representative of a company that manufactures medical gas systems and helped design and install the medical gas system at Angela's House II. After speaking with Bob and realizing that these children need our help he committed himself to do a 900 mile long bicycle ride from Chicago to Centereach, NY, along with his close friend William Iaia in 2006.

William and Jay rode with only a small backpack with water, a pair of shorts, a tee shirt, flip flops and a toothbrush with no escort of any kind. They rode an average 120 miles per day for 10 hours each day. Jay and William rode with the bare necessities and no escort because they felt that these children and their families do not have many of the luxuries that we have so why should we take the easy way out.

Jay D'Agostino is a resident of Centereach New York. He is 39 years old and lives with his wife, Eileen D'Agostino of 1 year. Currently they have no children but plan to within the next couple of years. Jay grew up in Lake Grove New York and is an Account Manager for a medical company that sells and services medical gas systems throughout New York and New Jersey. Jay works out 5 days per week and until last year never even had a road bike, or rode a bike 900 miles his

whole life. During the training for the ride he switched from gym workouts to riding 20 miles per night and 40-60 miles on the weekends.

William Iaia is 49 years old and is a resident of Patchogue, New York. William has been married to Tara Iaia for twenty six years and they have two sons, Eric, 22 and William 25. William grew up in Centereach but has lived in Colorado as well. William has been an avid bike rider for his entire life. He has ridden from Colorado to New York and from California to New York during his many years of riding.
